APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. Prepare a one-page document with the following information:

- Your name and email address
- Your accurate Grade Point Average
- Your year of study at the University of Arizona
- Your major and, if you have one, minor (OR your graduate program of study)
- A brief statement about why you would like to study in Orvieto, including the CLAS or RELI course(s) you intend to take while in Orvieto
- Any honors or particular distinctions that you have.

2. Deliver a **hard copy** of this document to **Dr. David Soren**, at the main office of the Anthropology Department on the 2nd floor of the Haury Building (School of Anthropology) or send it by campus mail to 314b Haury, addressed to Dr. David Soren.

***Your one-page summary should be RECEIVED by Dr. Soren and Marcela Thompson by **DECEMBER 1, 2016**. If you are a finalist, Dr. Soren will invite you for an interview, and you also will be asked to provide a short recommendation by letter or email from one of your professors.
